**Government Order No.914-JK(GAD) of 2024  
Dated:01.04.2024**

In terms of Section 135 B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, it is hereby ordered that:

- i) Paid holiday(s) shall be observed in the following Parliamentary Constituencies on the date(s) indicated against each, on account of General Elections to the Lok Sabha, 2024:

S. No.	Name of Parliamentary Constituency	Date	Day
1.	Udhampur	19 <sup>th</sup> April	Friday
2.	Jammu	26 <sup>th</sup> April	Friday
3.	Anantnag-Rajouri	7 <sup>th</sup> May	Tuesday
4.	Srinagar	13 <sup>th</sup> May	Monday
5.	Baramulla	20 <sup>th</sup> May	Monday

- ii) The poll days indicated above shall be observed as paid holiday to every person employed in any business, trade, industrial undertaking or any other establishment and is entitled to vote.
- iii) Daily wage/casual workers shall also be entitled for the Holiday and wages on the poll day.
- iv) A person who is ordinarily resident of a constituency and registered as an elector, serving/employed in an industrial undertaking or an establishment located outside the constituency including casual workers shall also be entitled to the benefit of a Paid Holiday on the day of poll.

It is further ordered that the above paid holiday(s) shall also be observed in terms of explanation to Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.
