NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 14 of the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946, the Government of Karnataka has exempted IT/ ITES/ Startups /Animation/ Gaming/ Computer Graphics/ Telecom/ BPO/ KPO/ Other Knowledge based Industries from the applicability of Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 for a period of five years vide Notification No: LD 194 LET 2016, dated: 25/05/2019. In continuation to this notification, the Government hereby exempts Orders) Act, 1946, for a further period of five (05) years from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette, subject to the following conditions:

- Each TI7 ITES/ Startups/ Animation/ Gaming/ Computer Graphics/ Telecom/ BPO/ KPO /other knowledge based Industries establishment shall constitute Internal Committee as per the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 and Rules framed there under.
- II. Each IT/ ITES/ Startups/ Animation/ Gaming/ Computer Graphics/ Telecom/ BPO/ KPO /other knowledge based Industries establishment shall constitute a representing employer and employees, to address any complaint/ grievances of any of the employee. The GRC shall be empowered to handle all types of complaints/ grievances of employee with a reasonable time frame.
- III. Each IT/ ITES/ Startups/ Animation/ Gaming/ Computer Graphics/ Telecom/ BPO/ KPO / other knowledge based Industries establishment shall intimate information about the cases of disciplinary action like suspension, discharge, termination, demotion, dismissal etc., of its employees to the Jurisdictional Deputy Labour Commissioner and Commissioner of Labour in Karnataka.
- IV. Any Information regarding service conditions of the employees of any IT/ ITES/
 Startups/ Animation/ Gaming/ Computer Graphics/ Telecom/ BPO/ KPO / other
 knowledge based Industries establishment sought by the Jurisdictional Deputy
 Labour Commissioner and Commissioner of Labour in Karnataka shall be
 promptly and fully submitted by every employer within the reasonable time frame



However, in case of The Industrial Relations Code, 2020 been implemented, the Code will apply to all.
