ORDER:-

In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad in the letter 2nd read above, Government after careful examination of the matter hereby decided to exempt all Information Technology Enabled Services (ITES) and Information Technology Establishments in Telangana State from the provisions of sections 15, 16, 21, 23 and 31 of the Telangana Shops and Establishments Act, 1988 for a period of one (1) year w.e.f 30.05.2023, subject to certain conditions

2. Accordingly, the following notification shall be published in the Telangana Gazette Dated: 17.11.2023.

- (xviii) The Integrated Registers shall be maintained and integrated Returns to be filed in terms of G.O.Ms.No.23, LET&F Department, dt: 24.03.2016.
