State Election Commission, Gandhinagar's letter No.: RACHA/Chatan/Sth.SW/110(2)/052025-K/181282 to 181461, dated 28/05/2025, as per the above-mentioned reading taken from the serial number No. (2) mentioned in the attached "Sheet-A", the elections to the Gram Panchayats except the Gram Panchayats under all elections in Kadi and Jotana talukas included in 24-Kadi (A.J.) Assembly Constituency and Visavdar, Bhensan, Junagadh (Rural) and Bagasra talukas of Amreli district included in 87-Visavadar Assembly Constituency will be held on Sunday, 22/06/2025.

State Election Commission dated 04/03/2009 Circular No.: RCP-Chatan-Sthasva-110-32009-K, under Point No. (H) of the instructions given regarding the action to be taken in connection with the elections to local self-government bodies, orders are to be issued to grant permission to workers to go to vote as part of declaring a local holiday/making alternative arrangements on the polling day.

Therefore, for the Gram Panchayat elections to be held in the state on 22/06/2025, under the Gujarat Shops and Establishments (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act-2019

- (1) Every person entitled to vote, employed in any shop or institution and whose weekly holiday does not fall on Sunday, the day of the election, dated 22/06/2025, shall be entitled to vote as an alternative arrangement for such employees/workers.

Arrangements should be made to provide special leave of three hours on a rotating basis or to provide leave on the day of voting in lieu of keeping the institutions open on the day on which there is a weekly holiday.

(2) The above shall not apply to any voter whose absence is likely to create a dangerous situation at the place of employment or whose absence is likely to result in extensive damage.

(3) The above shall also apply to daily wage/casual workers.

Instructions to give leave to workers for voting

The State Labour Commissioner has stated in a list that the Gram Panchayat elections in the state will be held on Sunday, 22/06/2025, from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM. Then, in order for the workers/employees of the institutions registered under the Gujarat Shops and Establishments (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act-2019 of that area to exercise their voting rights, on this day, as an alternative arrangement, such employees/workers should be given special leave of three hours for voting in rotation in the entire area under election or on the day when there is a weekly holiday, the institutions should be kept open and in lieu of that, leave should be given on the day of voting.
